

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING
LITTERING WITHIN THE
BOROUGH OF ELDRED AND
FIXING PENALTIES FOR THE
VIOLATION THEREOF.**

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF ELDRED**, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the
same:

Section 1 - Definitions For the purpose of this ordinance the following definitions shall be
applicable:

Junked motor vehicle means any motor vehicle which is partially dismantled or
wrecked and which cannot safely or legally be operated.

Motor vehicle means any self-propelled land vehicle which can be used for towing
or transporting people or materials, including but not limited to automobiles, trucks, buses,
motor homes, motorized campers, motorcycles, motor scooters, tractors, snowmobiles,
dune buggies and other off the road vehicles.

Motor vehicle accessories means any part or parts of any motor vehicle.

Section 2 - Littering Prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation or
other entity or any agent thereof to place, throw, store, accumulate or maintain, or cause
to be placed, thrown, stored, accumulated or maintained any used cans, papers, paper
boxes, used lumber, rubbish, debris, animal matter, garbage, scrap iron, junked motor
vehicles, motor vehicle accessories, tires, appliances, empty bottles or other containers

upon any property within Eldred Borough, McKean County, Pennsylvania, or on or near any alley, street, highway, river or stream located within said Borough, except in accordance with any Eldred Borough ordinance that would deal with collection of garbage, refuse, trash or solid waste and/or as part of any recycling program operated by the McKean County Solid Waste Authority.

Section 3 - Penalties. Any person, firm, corporation or other entity or any agent thereof, who violates this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Six Hundred dollars (\$600.00) and/or be imprisoned for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day that a violation of this Ordinance should occur after written notice is given by the Borough of Eldred or its duly appointed agent to the party responsible for the violation, shall constitute a separate offense, and shall be punishable as aforesaid.

Section 4 - Enforcement. This Ordinance may be enforced and administered by the Eldred Borough Council or any police officer of the Borough of Eldred.
