## ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 163 to fix the penalty for the violation of the Ordinance.

SECTION ONE: Section Three of Ordinance No. 163, adopted September 7, 1971 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION THREE: Any minor person as above designated found upon the Borough Street, alleys, parks or public places with the Borough in violation of Section One of this ordinance may be taken into custody by the Borough Police and delivered to his or her parents, guardians or person having the legal custody of said minor person. Thereafter, the said parent, guardian, or person having the legal custody of said minor person and the minor person himself, shall upon conviction thereof before a District Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to be imprisoned in the County Jail for not more than five (5) days at the discretion of the District Magistrate, and a like fine or imprisonment shall be imposed upon any person aiding or abetting in the violation of the intent and purpose of this Ordinance. Upon a second, and all subsequent convictions, as hereinbefore provided, of any person violating Section One of this Ordinance, a fine of at least Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars shall be imposed."

**SECTION TWO:** This Ordinance shall take effect on August 19, 1995.
